RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING THE NEW VISION MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH ON THEIR TWENTY-FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF MINISTRY

WHEREAS, New Vision Missionary Baptist Church was founded by Rev. Thomas J. Ferrell and 192 members in December 1999; and

WHEREAS, New Vision Missionary Baptist Church purchased the former Norwood English Lutheran Church at 3851 Montgomery Road in 2000, and held their first service there on December 9, 2000; and

WHEREAS, New Vision Missionary Baptist Church began their ministry walks through out Norwood and Evanston late in the winter of 2003-2004; formed their Praise and Flag Team Ministry in February 2004, and established their Feeding Ministry at the Walnut Hills Soup Kitchen in October 2004; and

WHEREAS, Stanton E. Thomas was installed as Pastor in 2010 and was elevated to Bishop in on June 23, 2023; and

WHEREAS, New Vision Missionary Baptist Church carried on the New Vision Food Drive Thru Pantry during the Covid pandemic, which has expanded to the Free Choice Pantry serving over 150 families per week; and

WHEREAS, New Vision Missionary Baptist Church began collaborations with Norwood Helping Norwood, other Norwood Churches, and other community resources to increase opportunities to address food insecurities; and
