RESOLUTION HONORING BRIGID KELLY

WHEREAS, it is fitting that the City Council of Norwood pay tribute to those exceptional citizens who have distinguished themselves through their impeccable service to the citizens of our great city; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Norwood recognizes March as Women’s History Month, and wishes to recognize a daughter of our city whose life has been dedicated to public service; and

WHEREAS, Brigid Kelly comes from a long family tradition of public service: her grandfather, R. Edward Tepe, having served as Mayor of Norwood from 1948 until 1957; and her father, Robert G. Kelly, having served as a member of City Council, then City Auditor, then City Law Director from 1980 through 1995; and

WHEREAS, Brigid Kelly was born and raised in Norwood, receiving formal education at Gressle School, Holy Trinity Grade School, Saint Ursula Academy, a Bachelor’s Degree at Xavier University in 2005, and a Master’s Degree at the University of Cincinnati in 2010; and

WHEREAS, Brigid Kelly served the citizens of Norwood as a member of the City Council for a term from 2006 through 2007; and

WHEREAS, Brigid Kelly represented Norwood as a member of the Ohio House of Representatives for three terms, from 2017 through 2022; and

WHEREAS, Brigid Kelly served the citizens of Hamilton County as Auditor in 2023 and 2024; and

WHEREAS, Brigid Kelly always makes the color green look good; and

WHEREAS, The Cincinnati Enquirer wrote that Brigid Kelly has built a reputation as one of the most genuine, well-meaning civil politicians in the Ohio Statehouse (27 July 2021); and

WHEREAS, Brigid Kelly sponsored a bill that ended sales tax on feminine hygiene products, which passed 84-1 in a highly-partisan Ohio Statehouse; and

WHEREAS, Brigid Kelly is widely known as a leader who conducts herself with kindness, perseverance, and, most importantly, integrity, enriching the lives of those fortunate enough to know and work with her; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

We hereby honor the outstanding career of public service by the Honorable Brigid Kelly and declare our gratitude for her service to our great city.
