Resolution No. 13 2024

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF NORWOOD, OHIO TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE METRO TRANSIT INFRASTRUCTURE FUND PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Metro Transit Infrastructure Fund Program provides funding for the general construction or maintenance of roads, bridges and related facilities involved in the provision of transit service by the regional transit authority, and

WHEREAS, the City of Norwood is planning to make capital improvements to Montgomery Road, Wayland Avenue and capital improvements to other infrastructure in the City that may be deemed necessary, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements herein above described are considered to be a priority needs for the community and qualified projects under the Metro Transit Infrastructure Fund,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Norwood:

Section 1: The Safety Service Director is hereby authorized to apply to the Transit Authority for funds as described above.

Section 2: The Safety Service Director is authorized to enter into any agreements with the Transit Authority as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3: This resolution is hereby declared an emergency resolution and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to apply in a timely manner for necessary public improvements.


